IT'S TIME FOR CAMP McCALL

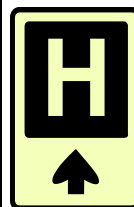




